



Dear Prospective Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in a seasonal Camp Staff position at Marin-Sierra. The Marin Council, Scouting America invites you to apply for an exceptional Summer job opportunity with the promise of great adventure during our 77th year of operation in scenic Emigrant Gap, California!

Staffing a Resident Youth Camp can be one of the more challenging, yet most rewarding experiences you will ever have. We say “rewarding” because staff members build lifelong friendships, develop better personal habits, learn new skills, experience working together independently and in teams, and much more! The word “challenging” is often used as well because while staffing a busy camp is certainly fun, it is also hard work. Most people don’t realize the energy and dedication expended to make Camp Marin-Sierra such a wonderful place for all who attend.

It has been said by experienced staffers, “if you are NOT looking for a few weeks of hard work outdoors, then you should probably find something else to do for the Summer!” However, for those Camp Staff alumni who return year after year, the rewards of making your character stronger and building your leadership abilities far outweigh the challenges.

Here's how the application process works:

- 1) Fill out the application form and send it to us as soon as possible; important directions are found on the cover page. Although there is no application deadline, most people apply before the end of the calendar year. Applying early may give you a better chance of interviewing and being offered the position you desire. However, if you are reading this after the first of the new year, go ahead and apply! Often there are many positions still available into the late Spring. **Be sure to include an email address that you check frequently because that is our primary means of communication.***
- 2) You will likely not hear back from us until late January. Interviews begin in early February and continue into late March primarily via ZOOM.*
- 3) Assuming you are interviewed during the first couple months of the new year, sometime in early March you will receive an email letter stating if you are hired. Next, you will receive an initial hiring packet by email in late March including a contract and pay rate, seasonal job description, numerous forms and important information. There will be a follow-up email in late April with additional online trainings required and other necessary paperwork.*

APPLICANT CONSIDERATIONS:

ALL POSITIONS require Scouting America membership registration through the Marin Council, with Criminal Background Checks (CBC) and LiveScan fingerprinting for all adults (18 years or older), or a School Work Permit requirement for all ungraduated minors residing in the state of California.

MOST POSITIONS, except for Counselor-in-Training (C-i-T) volunteers, are hired for the entire FIVE-week season. Rarely do we hire for partial-Summer terms, although we do make exceptions! Thank you for your understanding.

*In select cases such as Scouting America National Camping School (NCS) attendance, the Marin Council will pay for participant registration fees or provide the necessary training sessions locally.

**Specialized training sessions may include various NRA Basic Shooting, USA Archery, Restaurant ServSafe, or Emergency Medical Response-related certifications.

***All Aquatics/Waterfront Staff must have the American Red Cross Lifeguard Deep-Water certification, as well as the enhanced level of CPR/AED training for the Professional Rescuer.

****Counselor-in-Training (C-i-T) positions do not require any special training and are scheduled for a 2, 3 or 4-week volunteer assignment/commitment at the discretion of the Camp Director for experience in a variety of program or operational areas.

SCOUTS BSA SUMMER CAMP SEASON

Marin-Sierra will be in operation for the four full weeks of July starting Sunday 06/27/2027. In addition, everyone hired under contract will be required to attend Camp Staff training days during the week of June beginning Saturday 06/19 for key Leadership and Area Directors, or Sunday 06/20 for Program Area staff and Operations personnel. Applicants 16-years and older who are available for all five weeks are given priority in hiring, position and pay. **If you are NOT applying for the full season due to scheduling, please check below the camp weeks you are available:**

Counselor-in-Training (*C-i-T Program*): if you will be 14-17 years old at camp and available for a minimum of two-to-three weeks (Training week mandatory), then apply to be a **C-i-T** by writing that in the “Desired Position” above and check those weeks you will be available.
