

Dear Prospective Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in a seasonal Camp Staff position at Marin-Sierra. The Marin Council, BSA invites you to apply for an exceptional Summer job opportunity with the promise of great adventure during our 75th anniversary year!

Staffing a Resident Camp can be one of the most challenging and rewarding experiences you will ever have. We say "rewarding" because staff members build life-long friendships, develop better work habits, experience working together in teams, learn new skills and much more! The word "challenging" is often used as well because while staffing a busy camp is certainly fun, it is also hard work. Most people don't realize the energy and dedication expended to make Camp Marin-Sierra such a wonderful place for all who attend. It has been said by experienced staffers, "if you are NOT looking for a few weeks of hard work outdoors, then you should probably find something else to do for the Summer!"

However, for those Camp Staff alumni who return year after year, the rewards far outweigh the challenges. Those challenges only make our character stronger and of more value as adult citizens in our community.

Here's how the application process works:

- 1) Fill out the application form and send it to us as soon as possible; directions are found on the cover page. Although there is no application deadline, most people apply before the end of the year. Applying early may give you a better chance of being hired or getting the position you desire. However, if you are reading this after the first of the year, go ahead and apply! Often there are many positions still available. On the forms, be sure to use an email address that you check frequently because we communicate largely by email.
- 2) You will likely not hear from us until the new year. Interviews begin in early February and continue into late March primarily via ZOOM.
- *3)* Assuming you are interviewed during the first couple months of the new year, sometime around the middle of March you will receive a letter stating if you are hired. Next, you will receive a hiring packet in early April by US mail and follow-up email with all of your paperwork including a contract and pay rate, seasonal job description, numerous forms and important information.

SCOUTS BSA SUMMER CAMP SEASON

Marin-Sierra will be in operation for the four full weeks of July starting Sunday 06/29/2025. In addition, everyone hired under contract will be required to attend *Camp Staff training days during the week of June beginning Saturday 06/21 for Area Directors and Maintenance personnel, or Sunday 06/22 for Program Area Staff and Kitchen Crew.* Applicants 16-years and older who are available for all five weeks are given priority in hiring, position and pay. If you are not applying for all five weeks due to scheduling challenges, please check below the weeks you are available:

June 21/22 – 28 (Training) ____ June 29 – July 5 ____ July 6–12 ____ July 13–19 ____ July 20 – 27/28 ____

Counselor-in-Training (*C-i-T Program*): if you will be 14-17 years old at camp and available for a minimum of twoto-three weeks (including Training). If applying to be a **C-i-T**, write that in the "Desired Position" above and check those weeks that you will be available. This is strictly on a volunteer basis but provides valuable first job/camp staff experience.

APPLICANT CONSIDERATIONS:

ALL POSITIONS require BSA membership registration through the Marin Council, with Criminal Background Checks (CBC) and CAL LiveScan fingerprinting for all adults (18 years or older), or a School Work Permit requirement for all ungraduated school-age minors residing in the state of California.

MOST POSITIONS, except for Counselor-in-Training (C-i-T) volunteers, are hired for the entire FIVE-week season. Rarely do we hire for partial-Summer terms, although we do make exceptions. Thank you for your understanding in this regard.

*In select cases such as BSA National Camping School (NCS), the Marin Council will pay for participant registration fees or provide the necessary training sessions.

**Specialized training sessions may include various NRA Basic Shooting, USA Archery, Restaurant ServSafe, or EMR-related certifications.

***All Waterfront Staff must have either the American Red Cross or BSA Lifeguard certification, as well as the enhanced level of CPR/AED training for the Professional Rescuer.

****Counselor-in-Training (C-i-T) positions do not require any special training, and are scheduled for a 2-4 week assignment/commitment at the discretion of the Camp Director for experience in different program or operational areas.
