



NEW TREK PROGRAMS FOR SUMMER 2027:

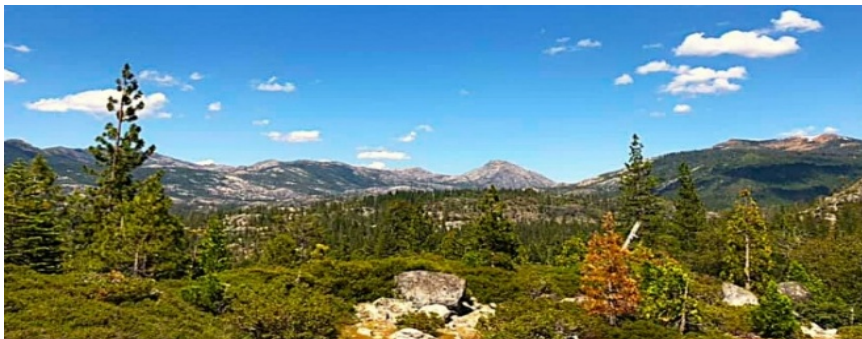
WEEKLY OUTPOSTS & JULY EXPEDITION

Camp Marin-Sierra offers your Scouts several unique options to participate in a genuine High-Adventure program, thanks to our base location at 5400ft elevation in scenic Emigrant Gap, high on the Western Slope of the Sierra Nevada surrounded by the Tahoe National Forest. These programs are ideal for your older Scouts to gain personal experience in a group setting beyond the usual Scouting merit badges and Summer Camp activities.



***Option #1** is a program rotation of high-adventure activities during our regularly-scheduled camp weeks that includes diverse guided sessions for climbing & rappelling our granite cliffs, canoe- or kayak-paddling on Chubb Lake, and muzzle-loading black-powder shooting at our Rifle Range, plus whitewater-rafting on the middle Truckee River and a 2-day/2-night backpacking outpost into the Fordyce Wilderness. This program is great preparation for your own Philmont or Northern Tier treks!*

***Option #2** is an additional "Trek" week at the end of July; 8-days and 50-miles on a backpacking expedition straight out of Marin-Sierra's back door into the Tahoe National Forest. This program includes outdoor leadership skills-building, "Leave No Trace" principles training, and a conservation project to meet the requirements of the special BSA 50-miler award from Scouting America. This option is attractive to Scouts who enjoy backpacking or may have missed out on unit expeditions to Philmont or other high-adventure bases.*
