Wood Badge consists of two parts. The first part is a six day experience where you will spend time at Scout camps learning leadership skills in order to better serve your BSA unit. These skills are also invaluable to all aspects of your Scouting, business and personal life.



During the second part, participants work on commitments made during the six days. A maximum of 18 months may be used to finish these goals in order to fully complete the course. Upon successful completion of Wood Badge, Scouters receive their beads of recognition and become members of Troop One, Gilwell.

Wood Badge is a 6-day course held over 2 weekends:

Friday - Sunday, August 25 - 27, 2017

Camp Tamarancho

AND

Saturday - Monday, September 16 - 18, 2017

Camp Marin Sierra

Participants must be on site (in uniform) and ready to begin no later than **8:30 a.m. on Friday**, August 25 and **9:30 a.m. on Saturday**, September 16. Arrangements can be made to spend the night previous to the start of each weekend. All participants must have Part A, B & C of the current BSA Medical Form in order to attend.

YOU CAN PARTICIPATE IN THIS AWESOME TWO-WEEKEND TRAINING COURSE IF YOU:

- 🦋 Are currently registered as an adult Scouter in a Cub Scout, Boy Scout, or Venturing unit, or if you hold a district or council position
- 🦋 Are at least 18 years old
- 🦋 Have completed Youth Protection Training and training specific to your Scouting position
- 🦋 Submit a completed application and pay the total fee prior to July 25, 2017.

COST

Fee for the course is \$250 if paid prior to May 31st, 2017 (\$275 thereafter). The course fee may be paid in installments. A \$75 deposit will hold your place. If unable to attend, your deposit will be refunded if you notify Redwood Empire Council in writing before July 25, 2017.

Course fees cover training materials, food, and equipment for the entire course as well as a course shirt and hat. The only equipment you will need is your personal camping gear, tent, and clothing. A detailed list will be provided.
