

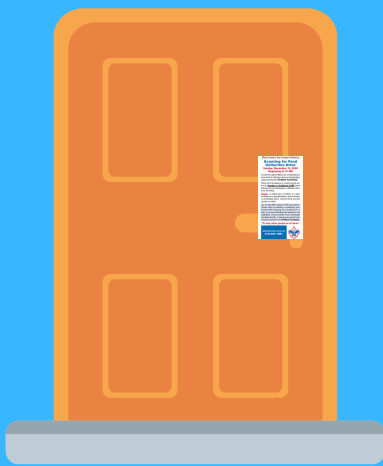
Scouting for Food 2022 Guidelines

**Important: Do not arrive at Food Bank
before 1:00 PM on 11/12/22!**



Basic Guidelines:

- Follow the Buddy System and Youth Protection Guidelines when distributing door hangers and collecting food.
- Wear Scout uniform.
- Adhere to the Scout Law - especially Friendly, Courteous, and Kind... Helpful is a given since you are collecting food for those in need.



Distributing Doorhangers:

- Plan routes in advance, assigning blocks to specific den/patrol groups.
- Walk as much as possible, weather permitting.
- Support vehicles should be mindful of pedestrians and other traffic.
- Set and show a safe example.
- Door hangers can be distributed anytime between Saturday 11/5/2022 and Tuesday 11/8/2022.

Donation Collection:

- Determine in advance which vehicles will be transporting donations to the food bank. Make sure all transporting drivers are aware of this year's timing and drop off at Food Bank between 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM on Saturday, 11/12/2022.
- Collect food using the same groups as distribution to help ensure all donations are collected.
- Support vehicles should "trail" Scouts and accept bags as they are collected.



Transporting donations to the Foodbank:

- Do not arrive at the Food Bank before 1:00 PM.
- Donations should be taken to SF-Marin Food Bank 2550 Kerner Blvd, San Rafael, CA 94901
- Members of the Talako Lodge, Order of the Arrow will be onsite to help unload your vehicle. For your safety, please remain in the car while we unload.
- As a best practice, wipe or disinfect surfaces on your car that were frequently touched.
